MALACCA: The Science, Technology and Innovation Ministry (Mosti) has spent a total of RM25.2 million under its Social Innovation Fund since the beginning of the year.

Its Deputy Minister Datuk Dr Abu Bakar Mohamad Diah said the sum was utilised to fund more than 70 projects aimed at benefitting Malaysians from all walks of life.

He said under the Social Innovation Fund, anyone with creative and beneficial ideas were encouraged to approach the ministry for financial assistance.

"We are hoping that such initiative will have a huge impact on our efforts to cultivate the culture of science, technology and innovation among Malaysians," he told reporters after opening the Information Centre and Tourism Transportation Terminal (Transpod) in Banda Hilir here today.

Present was Malacca Historic City Council (MBMB) mayor Datuk Zainal Hussin.

Abu Bakar said Transpod was built at a cost of RM360,000 and the project was a collaboration between MBMB and the Malaysia Design Council (MRM), an agency under Mosti.

He said the unique design of Transpod with the shape of the letter "M" was set to become another tourist attraction for the state.

Meanwhile, Zainal said Transpod, expected to be operational early next year, would serve as an information centre for tourists.

"Visitors can also get tickets for the Duck Tour as well as making complaints to MBMB." he added.
