Debugging the Web of cyberbullying

Help children deal with risks of
online harassment, says expert

PETALING JAYA: At least one in two young people have experienced cyberbullying, according to Digi CyberSAFE's Stop Cyberbullying 2017 survey.

The survey found that 58% of the respondents experienced cyberbullying on social media or chat apps, and 75% had received nasty messages in multi-player online games.

The survey was done in collaboration with CyberSecurity Malaysia in conjunction with the Stop Cyberbullying Day today.

"As estimates say there will be 500 million children in Asia who will be online by 2020, the occurrence of cyberbullying is likely to increase," said Mai Oldgard, senior vice-president of Telenor Group in a statement.

"This is the bullying of the 21st century; more invasive, maybe harder to notice and increasingly common. You can leave the phys-

ical schoolyard, but it's much more difficult to turn off the digital world," she added.

The survey, taken by 94 young people aged between 18 and 20, also found 66% of the respondents received unwanted sexual materials on social media and chat apps.

Chat apps make up the number one platform for which the respondents encountered these negative experiences, followed by social media, online games, email and then live streams.

"I encourage everyone to get educated on this new reality our children are facing, and help them deal with the risks of being online," said Oldgard.

Stop Cyberbullying Day will be launched today on www.digi.my/digicybersafe with social engagements by Digi CyberSAFE and its student ambassadors.

Mimos Semiconductor Catat Kejayaan Dalam Pengeluaran Wafer Grafen

KUALA LUMPUR, Jun (Bernama) -- Anak syarikat **Mimos Bhd**, Mimos Semiconductor (M) Sdn Bhd (MSSB), mencatat kejayaan dalam pengeluaran wafer grafen untuk aplikasi elektronik canggih.

Dalam kenyataan hari ini, MSSB berkata, penemuan itu akan memperkukuhkan keupayaan industri elektrik dan elektronik tempatan dalam meningkatkan rantai nilai dengan peranti Internet Kebendaan (IoT) dan elektronik bernilai tambah tinggi.

Pengurus Besar MSSB dan Naib Presiden bagi Sektor Elektrik dan Elektronik MIMOS, Wan Azli Wan Ismail berkata, selain kosnya agak rendah, kaedah yang digunakan untuk pengeluaran itu telah menghasilkan filem (lapisan) grafen ketulenan tinggi bagi memastikan kualiti tinggi ke atas bahan.

"Ini akan memberi kelebihan besar dalam pengeluaran semikonduktor generasi akan datang, pengesan foto, peranti tenaga, elektronik fleksibel serta peranti dan sensor nano boleh pakai.

"Kejayaan ini menjadikan Mimos Semiconductor sebagai pengeluar wafer grafen bersaiz lapang inci yang pertama dan satu-satunya di Malaysia," katanya.

KUALA LUMPUR, Jun (Bernama) -- Satu gempa bumi kuat berukuran 6.3 pada skala Richter melanda Kepulauan Kermadec, New Zealand pada 8.26 pagi, hari ini.

Jabatan Meteorologi Malaysia dalam satu kenyataan di sini hari ini berkata gempa bumi itu berpusat di 968km dari timur laut Taruga, New Zealand dan 7,798km tenggara Semporna, Sabah.

Gempa bumi itu dilaporkan tidak membawa ancaman tsunami.
