Govt scraps country's first geothermal power plant project

KUALA LUMPUR: The approval given to Tawau Green Energy Sdn Bhd to build the country's first geothermal power plant has been revoked on Aug 29, the Dewan Rakyat was told yesterday.

Energy, Green Technology, Science, Climate Change and Environment Minister Yeo Bee Yin said the government decided to scrap the project due to the firm's failure to carry out the project.

"There was no project progress and the drilling operations have ceased since the third quarter of 2016.

"It seemed that the company has ceased its operation and af-

fairs at the site.

"Hence, the approval was revoked and the approved capac-

ity quota of 37 megawatt from the project would be reallocated to new power plant projects with capabilities, especially in biogas, biomass and small hydro," she said in a reply to a question from Chan Foong Hin (DAP-Kota Kinabalu) on the status of the project in Tawau during the ministerial question time.

In answering a supplementary question, Yeo said the government was willing to call an open tender if there were firms

Prasyarat pembaharuan lesen: Kerajaan sedia disaman Lynas



KERAJAAN sedia berdepan tindakan undang-undang dari Lynas Corporation Ltd (Lynas), susulan prasyarat pembaharuan lesen Lynas Advance Materials Plant (LAMP) dikenakan terhadap syarikat berkenaan.

Menteri Tenaga, Teknologi, Sains, Perubahan Iklim dan Alam Sekitar, Yeo Bee Yin berkata, keputusan kerajaan itu berlandaskan undang-undang.

Ahli Parlimen Bakri itu berkata, prasyarat itu juga berdasarkan janji Lynas sendiri pada 2012 yang menyatakan komitmen untuk menghantar sisa radioaktif keluar dari Malaysia ke negara asal, Australia.

"Saya bercakap dengan Peguam Negara, Tommy Thomas pagi tadi (semalam), dan kita bersedia (berdepan tindakan undang-undang) kerana apa yang kita lakukan berdasarkan kedaulatan undang-undang.

"Lynas tidak boleh datang ke negara ini dan cuba menetapkan bagaimana kedaulatan undang-undang ditegakkan di Malaysia. Mereka juga tidak boleh meminta pengecualian seolah-olah berhak mendapat pengecualian itu," katanya di lobi Parlimen, semalam.

Beliau mengulas kenyataan Lynas yang mahu mempertimbangkan tindakan undang-undang terhadap kerajaan selepas Kementerian

an Tenaga, Sains, Teknologi, Alam Sekitar dan Perubahan Iklim mengenakan dua syarat untuk pembaharuan lesen LAMP.

Bee Yin berkata, Lynas kini menyimpan 450,000 tan sisa WLP dan berisiko tinggi kepada penduduk setempat, khususnya jika berlaku bencana seperti banjir besar.

"Berdasarkan undang-undang, sisa buangan yang boleh disimpan hanya kira-kira 20 tan atau 180 hari had simpanan sementara.

"Lynas perlu membawa sisa radioaktif ini keluar dari Malaysia kerana tiada lokasi selamat untuk menyimpannya di negara ini," katanya.

Katanya, syarikat itu didapati tidak mempunyai pelan pengurusan alam sekitar (EMP) di kawasan projek berkeluasan 4,046 hektar.

Dua kertas siasatan dibuka

"Kita sahkan dua kertas siasatan dibuka berkaitan kesalahan mereka. Siasatan lanjut sedang dilakukan termasuk mengumpul bukti di lokasi pembalakan dan mendapatkan dokumen se-

wajarnya.

"Sebaik siasatan dilengkapkan kita akan rujuk kepada timbalan pendakwa raya untuk mendapat izin pendakwaan," katanya di sini, semalam.

BH dalam laporan khas baru-baru ini, mendedahkan berlaku pencemaran di beberapa sungai di Hulu Sungai Lembing akibat pembalakan tidak terancang.

Ekoran pendedahan itu, siasatan menyeluruh dijalankan Jabatan Perhutanan dan JAS Pahang di kawasan pembalakan dan didapati berlaku pelanggaran syarat EIA.

Rosli memaklumkan pihaknya sudah memanggil wakil syarikat berkenaan serta kontraktor pembalakan bagi membantu siasatan.

Menteri Tenaga, Teknologi, Sains, Perubahan Iklim dan Alam Sekitar, Yeo Bee Yin berkata, keputusan kerajaan mengenakan prasyarat itu berlandaskan undang-undang.

Katanya, prasyarat itu juga berdasarkan janji Lynas sendiri pada 2012 yang menyatakan komitmen untuk menghantar sisa radioaktif keluar dari Malaysia ke negara asal, Australia.

"Saya bercakap dengan Peguam Negara pagi tadi dan kita bersedia (berdepan tindakan undang-undang) kerana apa yang kita lakukan berdasarkan kedaulatan undang-undang.

"Lynas tidak boleh ke negara ini dan cuba menetapkan bagaimana kedaulatan undang-undang ditegakkan di Malaysia.

"Mereka tidak boleh meminta pengecualian seolah-olah berhak mendapat pengecualian itu," katanya di lobi Parlimen, semalam.

Beliau mengulas kenyataan Lynas yang mahu mempertimbangkan tindakan undang-undang terhadap kerajaan selepas Kementerian Tenaga, Sains, Teknologi, Alam Sekitar dan Perubahan Iklim mengenakan dua syarat untuk pembaharuan lesen LAMP.

Syarat itu adalah LAMP perlu memastikan sisa *water leached purification residue (WLP)* yang mengandungi bahan radioaktif dihantar keluar dari Malaysia.

Bagi sisa buangan terjadual *neutralization underflow residue (NUF)* yang bukan radioaktif, LAMP perlu kemukakan pelan tindakan bagi pelupusan buangan terkumpul sebelum dipertimbangkan bagi permohonan kelulusan mengikut Peraturan 9 (6) dan 9 (7), Peraturan-Peraturan Kualiti Alam Sekeliling (Buangan Terjadual) 2005.

PAHANG DoE OPENS 2 INVESTIGATION PAPERS

Concession firm has no environmental management plan, says dept director

THE state Department of Environment (DoE) has opened two investigation papers in connection with the breach of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) regulations in upstream Sungai Lembing involving logging concession company Menti-ga Corporation Bhd.

Its director, Rosli Zul, said the investigations papers were opened after the company failed

to provide a water discharge control device as stipulated in the EIA regulations, which was issued in February 2014.

He said the company, which was awarded the logging licence, also did not have an environmental management plan for the project area covering some 4,046ha.

"We can confirm that two investigation papers have been opened against the offence committed by the firm... further investigations are being conducted, including collecting samples and proof at the logging site and gathering the necessary docu-

ments.

"Once our investigations are completed, we will refer the case to the deputy public prosecutor's office and seek permission to charge those involved in court," he said.

The New Straits Times Press, in a recent special report, revealed that some 500ha of jungle in Hulu Sungai Lembing had been felled indiscriminately without regard to the impact on the environment and on tourism in the surrounding areas.

Following the report, the state Forestry Department and Pahang DoE inspected the site and initial investigations revealed that there had been a breach of EIA regulations.

Rosli said DoE had called two representatives from the com-

pany, including the logging contractor, to facilitate investigations.

"The representatives provided their cooperation for us to complete our investigation papers. The case was investigated under Section 34A(7) of the Environmental Quality Act 1974, which carries a fine of not more than RM500,000 or a prison term of up to five years, or both."

He said DoE was working together with the state Forestry

Department to gather information to help complete the investigation papers.

Asked if there would be a stop-work order issued for logging until the probes were completed, Rosli said there was no need to do so as the logging at the site had been completed.

However, he said, the firm had been ordered to carry out mitigation works at the logging site as required by the EIA regulations.

WASHINGTON – Tarikan terhadap cahaya kebiruan-biruan ketika Matahari terbenam di planet Marikh kembali mendapat perhatian umum selepas beberapa gambar daripada kenderaan rover Curiosity milik Pentadbiran Angkasa dan Aeronautik Negara (NASA) dikongsi di media sosial.

Imej matahari terbenam itu kembali tular di Twitter apabila ramai pengguna media sosial bertanya kenapa planet Marikh yang dikenali sebagai 'planet merah' mempunyai cahaya senja kebiruan-biruan.

Warna kebiruan-biruan itu dikatakan terhasil selepas debu halus di Marikh 'menapis' cahaya matahari dan lebih memudahkan cahaya warna biru menembusi atmosfera planet tersebut.

Apabila cahaya biru itu bertebaran, ia lebih dominan berbanding warna lain. Langit senja Marikh juga kelihatan berwarna kuning hingga oren berikutan spektrum cahaya kuning dan merah berselerakan di langit.

Waktu senja di planet Marikh juga bertahan lebih lama daripada di Bumi disebabkan cahaya matahari dipantulkan oleh debu halus pada altitud tinggi ke arah sisi gelap planet tersebut. – Agensi

Pelepasan karbon dioksida sama 'kelajuan kereta api'

NEW YORK 6 Dis. - Kadar pelepasan gas rumah hijau global merekodkan peningkatan drastik dan dijangka mencatatkan rekod baharu, tahun ini sekali gus meletakkan dunia berdepan kesan pemanasan global lebih cepat daripada dijangka.

Para saintis menyamakan pelepasan karbon dioksida di seluruh dunia seperti kelajuan kereta api yang antara lain diakibatkan oleh keghairahan manusia memiliki dan menggunakan kenderaan yang digerakkan minyak dan gas.

Pensyarah Sains dan Sistem Bumi Universiti Stanford, Rob Jackson mendedahkan penggunaan minyak petrol menunjukkan peningkatan secara drastik dalam tempoh lima tahun.

"Itu adalah satu keadaan yang cukup memeranjatkan," katanya sebagaimana lapor *New York Times*.

Beliau merupakan satu daripada penulis dua kajian mengenai

Menurut penyelidik, pelepasan gas karbon diramal meningkat kepada 2.7 peratus pada tahun ini.

Usaha mengurangkan pelepasan karbon dioksida adalah amat penting untuk memastikan pemanasan global dapat dihentikan.

Tiga tahun lalu, lebih 200 negara terlibat dalam Perjanjian Paris yang tujuannya adalah untuk mengekalkan pemanasan global di bawah dua darjah *Celsius*.
