

Khairy announces queue-jumping prevention guidelines

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THE government has established “Guidelines to Determine List of Front-liners” to avoid queue jumping under the Covid-19 vaccination programme, said coordinating minister for the National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme Khairy Jamaluddin.
