The committee's co-chair, Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Khairy Jamaluddin retweeted the advice.

As of noon on Friday (May 14), 1,914,554 people have been vaccinated in Malaysia, with 732,310 completing their first and second doses and 1,182,244 receiving their first dose.

The committee also reported yesterday that 41.60% or 10,102,697 of those eligible for vaccination have registered for the vaccine.


