The Hotspots Identification for Dynamic Engagement (HIDE) technology announced by the Minister of Science, Innovation and Technology (Mosti) will be releasing the list of hotspots calculated as potential clusters this Friday.

MOSTI and National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme (NIP) coordinating minister Khairy Jamaluddin Abu Bakar said among the categories included in the hotspots that HIDE would identify are shopping malls, shopping outlets, bazaars as well as office premises.

"Anyone who has been to these spots will be identified as casual contact, and they are advised to self-monitor or isolate for symptoms.

"The HIDE system, which is considered as an enhancement to the existing contact tracing technology MySejahtera, will inform casual contacts from these potential clusters, and they should be tested only if they have the symptoms," he said during the announcement in Putrajaya today.
