"Every day, we go out and moet people. We are always exposed in the risk of infection. But for the sake of doing our job, we have to always ensure physical distancing, with frequent hand washing, using two pieces of face mask and always using disinfectant liquids," she said.

Meanwhile, in Kelantan, State Hedith director Donak Dr Zaini Hussin said nearly 100 media practitioners were scheduled to get the first vaccinarion doss starting from yesterday.

These media practitioners from various agencies, he said, were expected to receive the vaccine labs at the Darulmain Complex in Kota Baru.

He said more than 20 individuals should have been vaccinated yesterday. The rest would receive theirs by today.
