KJ: Vaccination in N Sembilan set to reach 80pct in October

The process of vaccinating 80 percent of Negeri Sembilan's 849,400 residents eligible to be inoculated is expected to be completed in October, with 20,000 doses of vaccine jabs to be administered daily from next month, said National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme (NIP) Coordinating Minister Khairy Jamaluddin.

He said the state is scheduled to receive a total of 600,000 doses of vaccines next month, with an increase in the number of vaccination centres (PPV), including industrial PPV, in the state...
