

At a press conference in Tangkak, Johor, on June 22, the Prime Minister announced that the daily allowance for healthcare volunteers involved in the Covid-19 vaccination process and management had been increased to RM100 from RM50, in appreciation of their contributions.

Meanwhile, Muhyiddin said that there were 579,150 persons with disabilities (OKU) registered with the Social Welfare Department and 280,904 of them had registered for vaccination under National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme (NIP) as of June 20.

Of the total, he said 15,914 had received their first dose and 3,859 had been fully vaccinated.

Muhyiddin also reiterated that the supply issue of vaccine delivery was not only faced by Malaysia but also other countries, due to monopoly by


