"The technical working group, comprising health and science experts under JKJAV, are of the view that much detailed study needs to be conducted prior to approving it, policy wise.

"We will be having another meeting on Wednesday next week to discuss this. There are some concerns with the side effects or adverse reactions if the Pfizer vaccine is administered in children and teenagers."

The Minister of Science, Technology and Innovation said this at a press conference here today after reviewing the process of administering Covid-19 vaccine to pregnant mothers at the Malaysia International Trade and Exhibition Centre (MITEC) vaccination centre (PPV).

The European Medicines Agency, US Food and Drug Administration and the US Centres for Disease Control have expanded the emergency use authorisation for the Comirnaty vaccine to adolescents aged between 12 and 15.

Following this, Malaysian experts have recommended the government start administering the vaccine to young people between 12 and 15-years-old.

Epidemiologist Professor Datuk Dr Awang Bulgiba Awang Mahmud, who is also head of the Independent Covid-19 Vaccination Advisory Committee (ICVAC) was earlier reported saying that plans should be made to ensure children are vaccinated sooner.

When the ICVAC suggested that 80 per cent of the population needed to be vaccinated, he said this included children under the age of 18 as they constitute almost 30 per cent of the population.


