THE massive drive to vac-FIE massive drive to vac-cinate pregnant women against Covid-19 contin-ued yesterday with some 2,600 of them getting the jab at the Sunway Pyramid Convention Centre (SPCC) vaccination centre (PPV). The SPCC and Malaysia Interna-tional Trade and Exhibition Centre

into J PPV are administering into only to pregnant women. The government's decision to prioritise pregnant women for vaccination is in line with the National Recovery Plan target to achieve berd immunity as soon as possible.

possible. SPCC PPV head Angela Lee said the vaccination process was smooth yesterday and the turnout

The turnout was good, but we had to defer some people due to medical reasons, as some had exceeded the recommended ges-tation period of pregnancy. Under the policy, vaccination is recom-mended (for pregnant women) between week 14 and week 33 (of pregnancy).

"For today's (yesterday's) programme, we specially arranged for six obstetricians and gynaecolosix obstetricians and gynaecolo-gists who are specialists from var-ious hospitals under the Sunway Healthcare Group to be stationed at the observation area specially for pregnant mums in case they have any concerns, problems or questions," she told the New Struits Times.
