Chinese nationals get jobs

PUTAJANG JAYA: A total of 280 Chinese nationals received their Covid-19 vaccinations at Palace of the Golden Horizon, says Khairy Jamaluddin.

The National Covid-19 Management Programme (NCMP) coordinating minister said Chinese nationals who were sent among the 280 who received their vaccinations at the hotel yesterday would get them at vaccination centres throughout the country.

"They will be vaccinated hopefully by next week," he said at a press conference broadcast by Reuters TV yesterday.

Khairy was visiting the hotel at Seremban where the special vaccina-

tion programme for the Chinese nationals living in Malaysia was being held.

He noted that there were 28,000 to 30,000 Chinese nationals living in Malaysia.

Meanwhile, Chinese Ambassador to Malaysia Geng Yujing said that since the Covid-19 outbreak last year, both governments had been working together.

He thanked the Malaysian government for NCMP, which he said had not only benefited Malaysian but foreigners including Chinese nationals.

"This reflects our solid friendship. As long as we work together, we can defeat the pandemic," he said.
