Starting from 2pm today, Malaysian citizens aged 40 and above or individuals with comorbidity who do not have any vaccine appointments, are not registered or have canceled registration can **walk-in to the nine designated PPVs**, says National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme Coordinating Minister Khairy Jamaluddin.

These nine PPVs are:

- Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC), HCO F
- Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC), HCO G
- Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC), HCO H
- Bangi Avenue Convention Centre (BACC)
- Hotel Wyndham, Klang
- Dewan Tun Razak, Sabak Bernam
- Dewan Komuniti Serendah
- Movenpick Hotel & Convention Centre KLIA , Sepang

This initiative, which will run until Aug 22, is for the administration of the first dose of vaccination and does not apply to individuals wishing to obtain a second vaccination dose.

“I would like to emphasise that the walk-in initiative in the Klang Valley is only for residents residing in the Klang Valley,” he said.

Prior to this, the Rembau MP had said that **to prevent the dissemination of fake news**, Khairy has reminded the public that not all PPVs would accept walk-ins.

“CITF will announce the list of PPVs in a couple of hours later, PPVs which are open (for walk-in vaccination). Do not assume that all PPVs (in Klang Valley) are open for walk-in,” he said.



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
