CITF updates walk-in vaccination initiatives for several states

PUTRAJAYA: The Covid-19 Immunisation Task Force (CITF) has updated the latest walk-in initiatives for states, including allowing individuals in Sabah who are above age 18 to walk in for their vaccination.

breastfeeding mothers to make appointments for vaccinations.

Senior citizens and disabled individuals residing in Pasir Puteh and Jeli would be allowed to walk-in while pregnant mothers, senior citizens and individuals with comorbidities in Tumpat are also allowed to walk-in for vaccination.

"We have also updated the walk-in initiative in Pahang, where walk-in for Malaysians, aged 18 and above, will be available in Bera beginning Sept 4, while the service will start from Sept 6 in Bentong, Lipis and Cameron Highlands," he said on Friday (Sept 3).

Dr Adham said that walk-in vaccinations in Perak will be available at all public PPVs for individuals who are 50 years and above and for disabled individuals, while those with comorbidities and pregnant mothers need to make an appointment.

In Perlis, walk-in vaccinations have been available to PPV Kubang Gajah since Sept 1 for all citizens and non-citizens.

Those in Johor can obtain vaccination through walk-ins at selected PPVs in their districts.

Dr Adham said that those in Sarawak who want to be vaccinated will have to refer to the nearest PPVs, adding that the walk-in initiative for those taking their first jab ends on Sept 6.

Individuals aged 40 and above residing in Kuala Muda, Yan, Padang Terap and Bandar Baharu in Kedah can walk-in to get inoculated while the service is available for citizens aged 18 and above in Kota Setar and Langkawi.


Non-citizens who are in Langkawi are also allowed to walk-in for vaccination.

"Senior citizens in Penang can now go to PPVs for inoculation while in Melaka, walk-ins are allowed for individuals 50 years and above as well as the disabled at public PPVs," he said.






