"Taking this into consideration, I would like to announce that the walk-in programme in Klang Valley will be stopped from Sept 15 onwards," said Dr Adham, at a job handover ceremony with Health Minister Khairy Jamaluddin.

In the recent new Cabinet announcement, the two ministers had their posts swapped.

Dr Adham said vaccination walk-ins in other states will remain as of now.

"Those in other states are advised to follow the announcements made by their respective state health departments for the walk-in programmes there," said Dr Adham.

The co-chairman of Covid-19 Immunisation Task Force (CITF) said its outreach programmes with non-government organisations will continue its 'mop-up' initiative.

"This is to ensure that no one is left out from our vaccination programme," said Dr Adham.

To date, 97.8% of adults in the Klang Valley are fully vaccinated.
