Ta Win hires Malaysian Nuclear Agency to help with new plant

KUALA LUMPUR: Ta Win Holdings Bhd, an integrated manufacturer of copper products, has appointed the Malaysian Nuclear Agency (Nuclear Malaysia) to help with the setting up of a new plant.

Nuclear Malaysia — which is under the Science, Technology and Innovation Ministry — will provide technical evaluation and consultation services to Ta Win's subsidiary, Cyprium Wire Technology Sdn Bhd (CWT).

The services will be provided during the commissioning and operation of electron beam irradiation systems at CWT's manufacturing facilities in the Alor Gajah Industrial Estate, Melaka.

The appointment was effective yesterday for two years.

The facilities will be Malaysia's first local privately-owned electron beam irradiation plant.

Ta Win group managing director Datuk Seri Ngu Tieng Ung said Nuclear Malaysia's appointment was an important milestone in facilitating the establishment of its

electron beam irradiation plant.

"As a leader in nuclear science and technology, Nuclear Malaysia will provide crucial technical know-how and expertise on the development and operations of the plant, including conducting inspections and site visits, and ensuring that CWT's irradiation protection protocols and safety procedures are in line with requirements."

Ta Win said the electron beam irradiation plant would fulfil the electrical wire and cable industry demand, and localise the production of electrical wire and cable products in Malaysia's manufacturing sector.

"This is part of Ta Win's acceleration into the EV (electric vehicle) segment, positioning the group to tap the opportunities in the global EV supply chain."

Ta Win plans to establish another two electron beam irradiation plants with the proceeds from its recently-announced private placement.
