In a recent certificate awards ceremony witnessed by Deputy Accountant General, Haji Rozaimi Idris and the Directors of various units in the AG's Department, the 20 accounting staff were presented the ICAEW Data Analytics certificates (after completing a 3-months intensive course) by Loh Wei Yuen, Head of Malaysia, ICAEW and coordinated by Zaiti Waddell of KAPLAN. These staff are now certified and have the ability to analyse larger datasets and are better equip to provide evidence-based insights and assurance in making decisions.
