Tang Rui: China attaches great importance to cooperation with Malaysia in vaccine research and development, and is willing to achieve the goal of producing human vaccines in 10 years as soon as possible

(Kuala Lumpur, 27th) Tang Rui, Minister of the Chinese Embassy in Malaysia, pointed out that the Chinese government attaches great importance to the cooperation in vaccine research and development between China and Malaysia.

China's CanSino Corporation, Malaysia's National Institute of Biotechnology and Malaysia's SolBio signed a tripartite memorandum of understanding on vaccine research and development cooperation on the 25th of this month. Attendees included Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Datuk Seri Aham Baba, Tang Rui and CanSino CEO Yu Xuefeng, among others.

Tang Rui delivered a speech at the event, saying that the Chinese government attaches great importance to the cooperation in vaccine research and development between China and

Malaysia, and actively promotes the connection between enterprises and scientific research institutions of the two countries. Therefore, the signing of the memorandum marks the substantial progress of the cooperation between the two sides.

"It is hoped that the vision of producing human vaccines within ten years as outlined in the "Malaysian National Vaccine Development Roadmap" will be realized as soon as possible through the cooperation in vaccine research and development between the two countries.

Aham Baba said that after the release of the "Malaysian National Vaccine Development Roadmap", the Ministry of Science and Technology established the Institute of Genetics and Vaccines to lead the research and development of human vaccines.

"The signed memorandum of understanding will start the long-term cooperation between the three parties in vaccine research and development and commercialization, and will also lay a solid foundation and indicate the direction for domestic vaccine research and development to be in line with international standards."

Tang Rui and Ahan Baba witnessed the signing of the memorandum of understanding between the three parties and answered questions from reporters on China-Malaysia vaccine research and development cooperation. During the event, the guests also watched the demonstration of CanSino's latest inhaled new crown vaccine.
