KUALA LUMPUR: The Malaysian satellite has been successfully launched!

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob and 600 guests witnessed the historic moment of the satellite launch at the French Guiana Space Centre in a live broadcast from the Merdeka Conference Hall of the World Trade Centre (WTC) this morning.

The satellite was safely launched by the Ariane 5 rocket at 5:50 am Malaysian time (6:50 pm French time on June 22), but due to additional inspections, the flight was delayed by 47% from the original time. minute.

The first separation of MEASAT-3d from the rocket took place at 6.19am Malaysian time, the second at 6.34am and was accurately received seven minutes later at 6.41am, transmitted from space to Earth the first signal.

The RM1.2 billion satellite, with a lifespan of 18 years, is expected to be able to bridge the digital connectivity gap and shape a better future of connectivity for Singaporeans through the government's National Digital Network (Jendela) initiative.

The Prime Minister was also on Facebook, sharing the 10 seconds before the countdown to the satellite rocket and the moment when the rocket was launched.

Witnessing together included Minister of Communications and Multimedia Dato Seri Annuar Musa, Deputy Minister Datuk Chahidhi, Minister of Science, Technology and Innovation Datuk Seri Dr Aham Baba, Chairman of Astro Group Malaysia Tunku Ali Li Dao Ding, MEASAT director Shah Luli Shahashan and others.
