

Equity Fund Investors Gets A Chance To Invest In VC Fund Through Emissary Capital

This unique microfund structure has enabled sophisticated and angel investors to access a portfolio of deals instead of individual start-ups. This investment could dilute the risks that the ECF investors face. Since Emissary invests in late-stage start-ups, the risks that its ECF investors face could be lower than those who invest in earlier-stage start-ups through ECF platforms in their own capacity.

Karen Puah, country manager of Fundnel Malaysia, said venture capital is one of the most exciting asset classes to invest in right now.
