Malaysia Cyber Security Awards 2017

KUALA LUMPUR (12 October 2017) – Malaysia's thriving cyber security industry is expected to continue on its robust growth trajectory in 2017 and beyond, fuelled by the significant contributions from local cyber security organizations and visionary IT security leaders. In recognition of their outstanding achievements, CyberSecurity Malaysia presented selected individuals and organizations with the prestigious Malaysia Cyber Security Awards (MCSA) 2017.

The Malaysia Cyber Security Awards 2017 were conferred at the closing of Cyber Security Malaysia – Awards, Conference and Exhibition (CSM-ACE) 2017. The awards received enthusiastic response and have since become a driving force for innovation, commitment, leadership and corporate excellence within the cyber security sector in Malaysia.

Recipients of MCSA 2017 received their accolades at a glittery gala dinner officiated by YB Datuk Seri Panglima Wilfred Madius Tangau, Minister of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI).

There must be more cross-border collaboration, as well as public and private partnerships to develop a national cyber security innovation ecosystem that will transform cyber security challenges into new opportunities, ideas and solutions," said YB Datuk Seri Panglima Wilfred Madius Tangau at the award presentation ceremony.

Malaysia Cyber Security Awards 2017 celebrates outstanding individuals and organizations over six categories that have made significant contributions to Malaysia's cyber security industry. The awards are conferred in recognition of innovativeness, commitment and dedication, leadership and sound business strategies.

Nomination for MCSA opened in June 2017 and the list of potential candidates were submitted by industry players through CyberSecurity Malaysia's microsite. The nominees were meticulously vetted by Deloitte and the final list were decided by a distinguished panel of judges comprising senior management and representatives from Economic Planning Unit of Prime Minister's Department. Communication and Multimedia Commissioner, PIKOM as well as Universiti Teknikal Malaysia Melaka (UTEM).
